



Nomination of Candidates and Election of CAAPA Officers

NOMINATIONS – Any member who is eligible and is deemed to be qualified for office in AAPA may nominate a candidate for CAAPA office.

Offices for which nominations are in order for 2009 are:

- **PRESIDENT-ELECT**
- **VICE PRESIDENT**
- **TREASURER**
- **SECRETARY**

Nominations shall take place in a regular meeting, at a district conference, or at a special meeting called for that purpose, respectively.

Nomination shall be by ballot and a majority affirmative vote of those present and voting shall be required for nomination.

In the event there are no nominations for any given office, a special committee shall be appointed by the president of CAAPA within 15 days from the closing date of nominations to act as a nominating committee for that office.

Position shall be a two year term commencing October 1st and ending September 30th.

October 1st through December 31st immediately following a term in office shall be considered an introductory period for the incoming team. The outgoing officer must agree prior to election to be available during the immediate past term to assist during this transition period.

ELIGIBILITY – Eligibility for CAAPA officer positions shall consist of:

1. Active membership in National AAPA which is in good standing;
2. Active membership in Chicago Chapter AAPA which is in good standing;
3. Have served one term previously in another office (for president-elect);
5. Have financial experience (for treasurer).
